Let x = CGPA and y = percentage of marks

Then the conversion formula from CGPA to percentage of marks is

$$y = \frac{20}{7} (4x - 5)$$

All Post Graduate students of the Institute may use the formula for conversion from CGPA to percentage of marks as mentioned above.
